Important point to consider



Edge (1993, p. 74) suggests that teacher should not insist the use of English if the level of frustration on a particular occasion becomes negative. If the students really cannot understand the teacher, or if a student really cannot express something that he or she clearly very much wants to say, then the use of L1 is needed.


