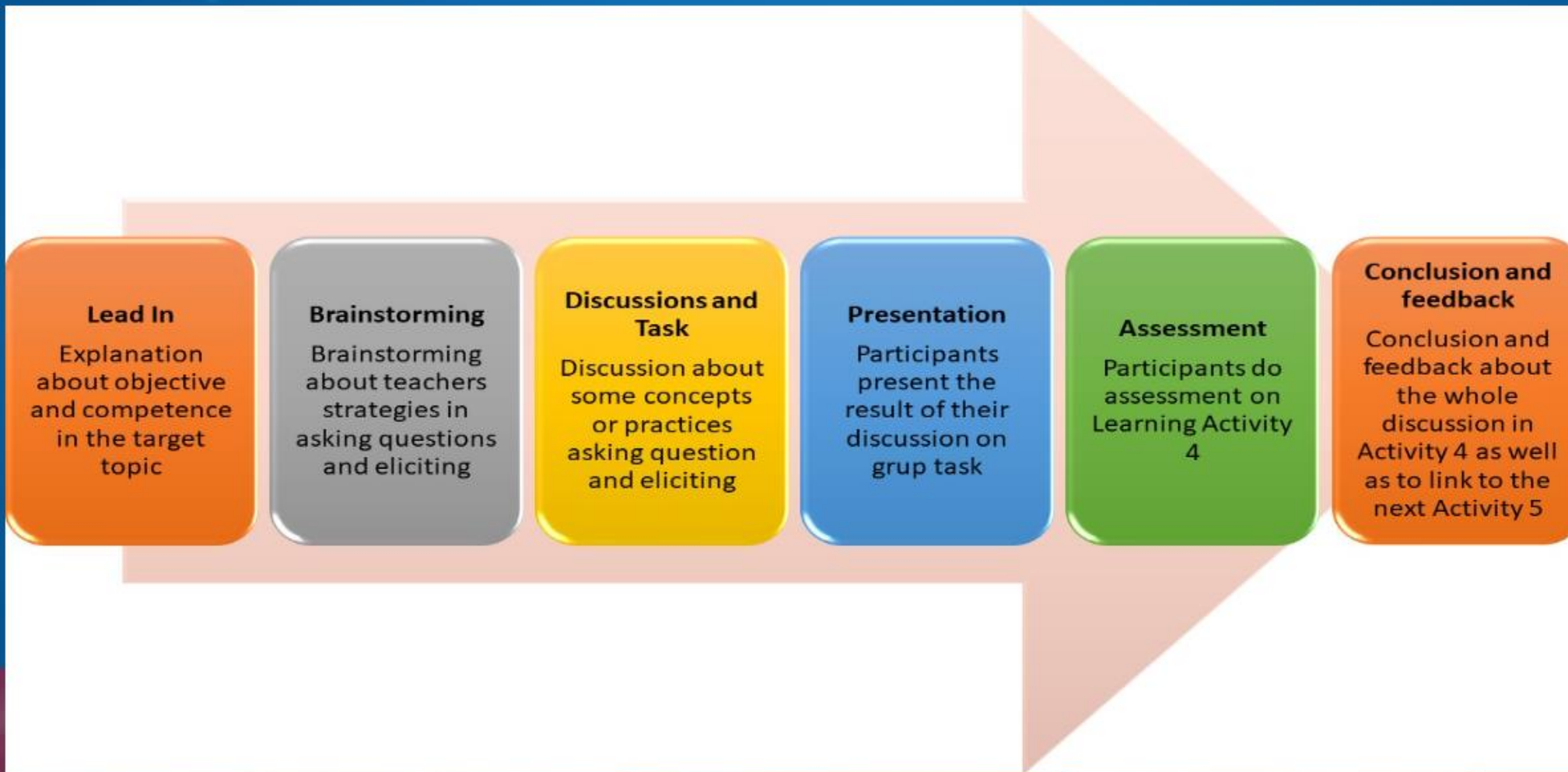

Asking Questions and Eliciting



The most important key to create an interactive language classroom in the initiation interaction by teacher.

One of the best way to develop teacher's role as an initiator is a repertoire of questioning strategies (Brown, 2001, p.169).

In some classrooms over half of class time is taken up with question-and-answer exchanges.

Questions play a crucial role in language acquisition.





Term which describes a range of techniques which enable the teacher to get learners to provide information rather than giving it to them.

Commonly, eliciting is used to ask learners to come up with vocabulary and language forms and rules, and to brainstorm a topic at the start of a skills lesson.



The definition of the term in the Dictionary of Language Teaching and Applied Linguistics, 'Techniques or procedures which a teacher uses to get learners to actively produce speech or writing', suggests that there may be wider applications

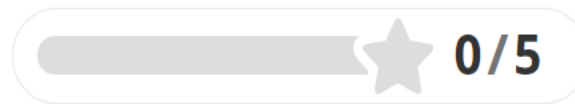
